NHI BY THE NUMBERS

- Since 1979, over 100,000 youth have participated in NHI learning experiences
- 98% enroll in college after high school
- 90% of members are admitted to selective colleges and universities
- 90% of NHI members complete their undergraduate studies in 5 years or less
- Members attend out-of-state colleges at twice the national average
- More than 75% of NHI participants receive tuition support from community leaders and organizations
